In 2017 we provided shelter and housing services for 229 families, but we had to turn away over a thousand families due to lack of capacity. 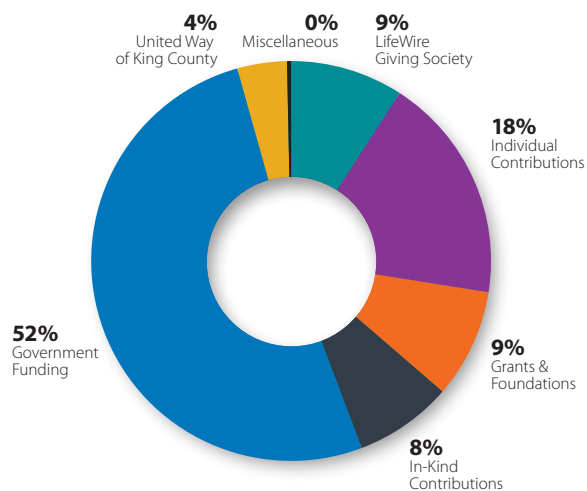

NET ASSETS

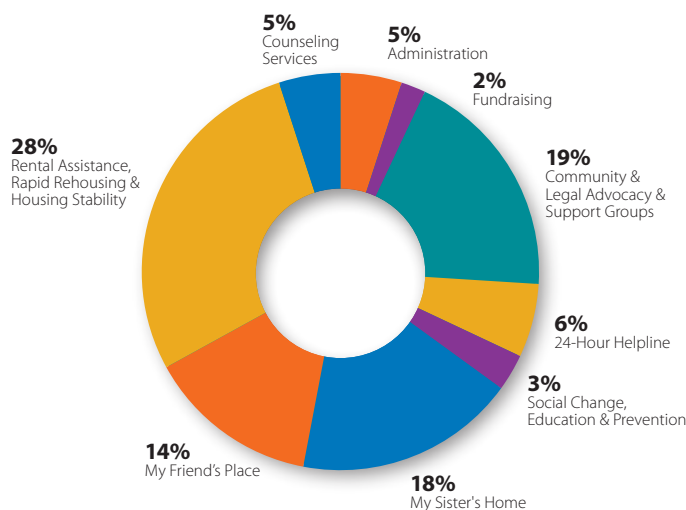
Change in Net Assets	385,802
